CALL FOR PAPERS

The Alternative Dispute Resolution Journal is a biannual, regional journal published by the Arbitration Center at American Chamber of Commerce in Kosovo. The work of the Arbitration Center is focused on facilitating the resolution of businesses disputes through arbitration and mediation as alternative dispute resolution methods, as well as providing quality and efficient arbitration services to the business community in Kosovo and abroad.

The Arbitration Center at American Chamber of Commerce in Kosovo is pleased to announce the third volume of the journal, which is expected to be published in November 2016. The Journal intends to strengthen the promotion of knowledge and legal research in the field of arbitration, this way being consolidated into a platform where legal practitioners, academics, and law students can share their expertise, comment on best practices pertaining to arbitration proceedings, comment on legislation, and discuss ideas related to this topic.

The Editorial Board issues this call for papers seeking contributions related to arbitration, including but not limited to analysis of local arbitration legislation and rules; landmark cases or current arbitration cases which have set legal standards that continue to be applied, or that have raised important legal issues; comparison of arbitration proceedings with judicial proceedings; empirical or other studies on the advantages of arbitration (and/or mediation); presentation of original research on arbitration and/or mediation; or best practices in arbitration and/or mediation, in one of the following formats:

1. Essays (between 7000 and 10000 words), preferably comparative works;
2. Developments (5000 - 10000 words);
 - Legislation, or
 - Practice.
3. Case reports (up to 5000 words);
 - Arbitral awards (domestic/international), or
 - Court cases (domestic/international).

The Arbitration Center is accepting papers on a rolling basis. For applicants who wish to submit their papers for the upcoming volume, **the deadline for submission of the paper plans is September 1, 2016.** The plans should be sent to arbitration@amchamksv.org and include the following:

- Title of the article;
- Abstract (250 - 300 words);
- A short personal biography (approximately 100 words).

The Editorial Board of the Journal will invite the successful applicants to submit the draft papers for publication. **The deadline for final submissions will be October 10, 2016.**
